Fraud Tips

NEVER keep your PIN Number with your Debit card, if someone gets ahold of it they can use your card at any ATM!

If your card is lost/stolen after normal bank hours, call 800-383-8000 to report it. That way nobody will be able to use your card until you can get ahold of your banker.

Check your statements often, and report any unknown transactions ASAP!

Never click on links from suspicious sources, when in doubt find the company’s website or customer service number and call to verify legitimacy. Don’t call any numbers that are provided by the email/ message in question.
